Destination

EC Brighton is an English language centre offering an exciting 2 week programme for mature clients, combining learning with the opportunity to explore England with like-minded people.

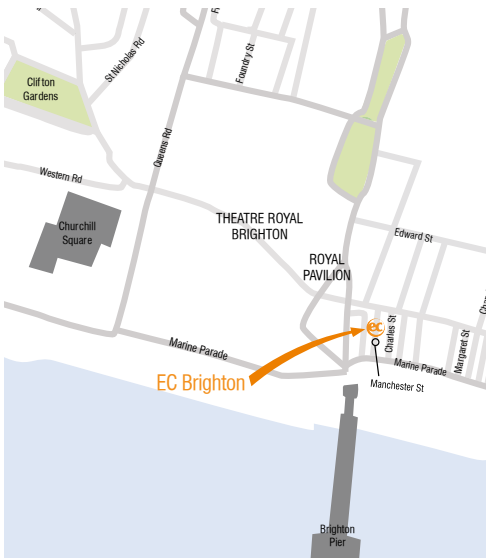
Lessons

You will have 20 lessons per week in a small group of a maximum of 6 people. The course is highly practical and focuses on using the English language confidently in everyday situations, such as asking for directions and information, making reservations and socialising. Our experienced teachers create a relaxed atmosphere in which you will enjoy learning English.

You will meet lots of interesting people on this course so it is ideal if you are travelling on your own, with a friend or spouse.

You can stay with one of our welcoming host families; breakfast and evening meal are included.

- Course duration 2 weeks
- 20 lessons per week
- Accommodation on half board
- Full leisure programme
- Maximum 6 in class



Accommodation:

Host families are situated within a 30-minute radius by bus from the school. Chosen for their caring attitude, our host families offer warm, comfortable homes to return to after a day at school. Whilst staying with a host family you will receive a lot of exposure to the English language, culture and way of life. EC's accommodation department staff members visit all host families before they are accepted to host students and then follow up with regular home visits to ensure the comfort and safety of the students.

Homestays Include:

- Bed linen and towels are provided
- Students can choose either breakfast only or breakfast and an evening meal
- Linen and towels are changed once a week
- Families offer laundry facilities once a week
- Rooms include a bed, a wardrobe and access to an area where students can do their homework (either in their room or in a common area of the house)

With advanced notice we do our best to accommodate any special requests that you may consider necessary for their well being eg. non smoking family, no pets, allergies, special dietary requirements etc. However you should bear in mind that this may not always be possible.
