



EC Brighton Junior Programme Rules and Regulations



Students staying in host families

- **Always ask your host family before using the kitchen or telephone**
- **Let your host family know what time to expect you for dinner**
- **Ask for your host family's permission before bringing any guests home**
- **Make sure you do not lose the house key or lend it to anyone**
- **Remember that you are staying at someone's home and not in a hotel so be polite and treat your host family with respect**

Students staying in residence

- **Do not bring guests into the residence without permission from your residence supervisors**
- **Girls are not to enter boy's rooms, showers and toilets and vice versa**
- **Don't miss meals without informing your residence supervisors**
- **Do not disturb other students staying in the residence at night**
- **Always follow instructions given to you by the residence supervisors**
- **Do not play with fire extinguishers and fire alarms. It is a criminal offence!**
- **If you use anything in the common area kitchen, you should clean it yourself after using it**
- **On your day of departure you should vacate the room by 10:00 am; if you are leaving later on during the day you must stay in the common areas**

- **Always keep your room door locked, even if you go out for a short time**

All Students

- **If you lose your room key, you have to pay £20 for it so keep it safe**
- **Keep your room neat and tidy and make your bed in the morning.**
- **Make sure you do not damage anything in the host family's home, residence or at the school. You will have to pay for all damages.**
- **Don't bring anyone who is not a student at EC into the school buildings without the permission of the Academic Co-ordinator.**
- **Don't leave the school buildings between lessons without the permission of the Academic Co-ordinator.**
- **Don't go to the beach, Brighton Pier or Churchill Square in the evenings.**
- **NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOL, SMOKING OR TAKING OF ANY DRUGS ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS, IN YOUR ACCOMMODATION OR ANYWHERE ELSE. IT IS ILLEGAL TO SMOKE IF YOU ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 16 AND ILLEGAL TO DRINK ALCOHOL IF YOU ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 18.**
- **Always be polite and queue when in a shop or bus stop.**
- **Always be polite and considerate of others when travelling on the bus.**
- **Do not litter the classrooms, school grounds or on the street.**
- **Switch off your mobile phone during class.**

- **Don't be late for class or your activities.**
- **You must attend ALL activities. If you have a problem, phone your social leader.**
- **Don't block paths. If you need to gather together as a group find an area with plenty of space.**
- **Don't steal. If you are caught you will be arrested and sent back to your country.**
- **Do not disturb the neighbours on your way home at night.**
- **All personal belongings should be locked up safely when you are not in your room. We have a safe for valuables like passports at the school. EC CANNOT be held responsible for anything that goes missing.**
- **Bullying, intimidation and general misconduct are NOT acceptable for any reason. YOU WILL BE EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL AND SENT BACK TO YOUR COUNTRY.**
- **You must respect curfew and lights-off times (see below)**

CURFEW TIMES

Students under the age of 16 years old must be at their host family/residence by 22:00

All other students must be at their host family/residence by 23:00

LIGHTS OFF

All students must be in bed with the lights switched off by 23.30.
