Airport Transfers

Airport transfers are included in the price of Junior Programmes. Students must arrive on Sunday and depart on Saturday between 08.00 - 20.00 otherwise, an extra transfer fee will apply. Students are met at the barrier in the Arrivals Hall by an EC representative holding a card with the logo of the school - "EC Cambridge".

It is vitally important that if students miss their connection to the UK, they must contact the emergency number to make EC Cambridge aware they have been delayed. Students must expect a maximum wait of 2 1/2 hours before departing from the airport. Students are then taken to a meeting place where their host family or EC social leader will be waiting.

Information regarding arrival time, flight number, airline, name of airport and terminal number must be sent to EC Head office at least 5 days before the student's arrival. If this information does not reach us within the stipulated time EC Cambridge will not be responsible for providing airport transfers to the student and will not offer any compensation to students who have not been collected because of this.

Welcome Pack

A Welcome Pack is given to students on their first day of school. This Welcome Pack contains directions to the school along with other information the student will find useful during their stay. For students staying in residential accommodation, their EC social leader will escort them to school on their first morning.

First Day at School

Students should be in school by 08:30 on their first day in order to sit their placement test; this assesses the student in all key skill areas, allowing academic staff to place students in the relevant group for their ability. All students must present their passport/ID on arrival at the school on their first day as proof of identity.

Welcome Talk

The students will be given a welcome talk by the Academic Department where timetables, lessons and academic information are explained. Leisure programmes and activities are also explained at this time by the Programme Manager.

Bus Passes

In order to travel to school students staying in host family accommodation are advised to purchase a bus pass. Bus passes cost approximately £11.50 per week and can be purchased on the bus.

Placement test

On their first day all students sit a placement test in order to be allocated to the most appropriate English language level.



Double Banking Explained

Please note that after their first day, students may be on a double bank/zig zag time table where they would have classes in the morning one week, and in the afternoon the next. Note also that EC Cambridge reserves the right to change the times of the timetable.
