Description of local area:

Set in 42 acres of open parkland in the north west corner of the city, Churchill College's location is a 15 minute walk from the historic city centre. There are a number of interesting places well worth visiting in Cambridge, all easily accessible from Churchill College Cambridge

Gatwick, Heathrow and Luton airports are all within two hours drive, and Stansted is just a 40 minute journey.

Journey to school:

Walking distance to the school: about 25 minutes;
By public transport: 15 minutes

Description of Student House:

Accommodation is offered in contemporary courtyards that surround the main building and the heart of the college campus. The College's rooms are light and generously proportioned and include a bed, spacious desk, wardrobe and sink. Shared bathroom facilities are available on each floor and include both baths and showers. Bed linen and towels are provided and rooms are serviced once a week. There is a subsidised student cafeteria. The college is a 20 minute walk into the city centre.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are all served in the hall between the following times:

Breakfast: 07:30 - 09:30

Lunch: 12:30 - 13:30

Dinner: 18:15 - 19:00

Types of rooms: Single

Board Status: Canteen available for food and drinks

Notes:

- Check-in after 14.00.
- Check-out by 10.00 on morning of departure.
- Internet is free and available at 4 web access terminals around the College. An ethernet cable is required for access and this can be purchased from the Porters' Lodge for £4
- Sports facilities are available and subject to availability. Keys and racquets are available against a refundable deposit.
- A refundable damage deposit is collected at the school upon arrival.
- Student houses are not suitable for students aged over 28 years.
- Smoking is not permitted in the student house.
