King's Cross - Summer Superior Residence

Description of local area:

In the heart of London, the residence is located near King's Cross Station. One of London's oldest markets, Chapel Market, is just five minutes walk. The main Islington shopping area is also nearby and has a good range of stalls, shops and cafés at reasonable prices. This is one of the most densely populated and multi-cultural areas in the capital. The residence is surrounded by shops, restaurants, pubs and cinemas.

Description of residence:

The bedrooms are arranged into flats of 5-7 rooms, which share a large kitchen. Each bedroom has an en-suite shower, WC and basin and is equipped with a bed, desk, chair and lots of storage space. The residence has 24 hour reception / security. Students can socialise or watch television in the common room where there are also vending machines for drinks and snacks. The residence has a garden where they can enjoy the summer sun.

All apartments include an en-suite shower, toilet and washbasin plus separate telephone and data points for high-speed internet access. There is also a fully fitted kitchen and living/study area.

Journey to school:

The quickest way to get to EC London is by London underground. The total journey time is approximately 30 minutes.

Cleaning:

Rooms are cleaned weekly and bed linen is changed once a week.

Laundry facilities:

Coin-operated laundry facilities available at the residence, (open until 10pm)

Internet:

Free Wi-Fi is available in common areas. Cabled internet is accessible in the student rooms. Cables are available from the reception at an extra charge.

Important notes:

- EC must be notified of student arrival arrangements and expected times of arrival.
- Check in time: Sunday 2 pm
- Check out: Saturday 10 am
- Bed linen provided and students must bring their own towels
- Smoking is not permitted in the residence
- A damage deposit of £150 will be collected upon arrival, this is refunded in full on check out
- Cancellation prior to arrival: Students cancelling their accommodation fewer than 14 days before arrival will be charged a one week accommodation fee - charged at the standard accommodation rate and accommodation placement fee.
- Cancellation after arrival: Bookings of 7 weeks or less: No accommodation refund. Bookings of 8 weeks and over: Students must give notice in writing 4 weeks prior to termination otherwise a 4 week cancellation fee will apply.
