Airport Transfers

Airport transfers are included in the price of Junior Programmes. Students must arrive on Sunday and depart on Saturday between 08:00 - 20:00 at Heathrow or Gatwick. If students arrive or depart outside these times an extra transfer fee will apply.

EC airport reps (or EC drivers) will meet junior arrivals from their flights at international Arrival Halls at the main airports. Airport Reps will be wearing an EC T-shirt / Holding up an EC sign and will direct students to the driver for their transfer to London. It is vitally important that if students miss their connection to the UK, they call the emergency number to make EC London aware they have been delayed.

Students should expect to wait up to 2 hours before departing from the airport. Students staying with a homestay provider are dropped off by their driver either at a central meeting point or directly to their homestay residence.

Information regarding arrival time, flight number, airline, name of airport and terminal number must be sent to EC Head office at least 5 days before the student's arrival. If this information does not reach us within the stipulated time EC London will

not be responsible for providing airport transfers to the student and will not offer any compensation to students who have not been collected because of this.

Welcome Pack

A Welcome Pack will be sent to host families or residences before the student's arrival. This Welcome Pack contains a map with directions to the school, the exact time students need to be there on their first day and other information the student will find useful during their stay.

First Day at School

On the first morning students will be dropped to the school by their homestay parent and will arrive at the school by 8.45 latest.

All students must present their passport/ID at Reception on arrival at the school on their first day as proof of identity.

Students will be given a welcome talk and presentation about the school. This will be followed by a placement test and finally lessons which will run till midday.

All students will be taken to and from school every day. They will travel with the homestay parent and the choice of transportation will vary from private car, bus, tube, train and walking.

Placement Test

When students arrive at school they sit a placement test which assesses their grammar & vocabulary. Speaking and listening skills are also assessed. The test takes about 1.5 hours to complete and the purpose of it is to help the school place students in the appropriate class at the right level. This will allow the students to make the most of their time and help the teachers plan the lessons according to the students' linguistic needs.
