



King's Cross - Summer Residence

In the heart of London, the residence is located near King's Cross Station. One of London's oldest markets, Chapel Market, is just five minutes walk. The main Islington shopping area is also nearby and has a good range of stalls, shops and cafés at reasonable prices. This is one of the most densely populated and multi-cultural areas in the capital. The residence is surrounded by shops, restaurants, pubs and cinemas.

Description of Accommodation

The bedrooms are arranged into mixed gender flats of 5-7 rooms, which share a large kitchen. Each bedroom has an en-suite shower, WC and basin and is equipped with a bed, desk, chair and lots of storage space. Students can socialise or watch television in the common room where there are also vending machines for drinks and snacks. The residence has a garden where they can enjoy the summer sun. All apartments include separate telephone and data points for high-speed internet access.

Journey to school The quickest way to get to EC London is by London underground. Walk to King's Cross station and take the London Underground Piccadilly line train to Holborn station. On leaving Holborn station, cross over the road (Kingsway) towards Sainsbury's supermarket. Walk past the supermarket up High Holborn. Turn into the second road on your left (Smart's Place) and then right into Stukeley Street. The school entrance is on the right hand side of the road. The total journey time is approximately 30 minutes.

Arrival and departure EC must be notified of student arrival arrangements and expected times of arrival.

Nearest Station to the Residence King's Cross St. Pancras Station – Piccadilly, Northern, Victoria, Hammersmith, Circle and Metropolitan London Underground lines; British Rail and Thameslink services.

Travel Card Cost Zone 1-2 £27.60 per week / £ 106.00 per month (Students can get a 30% discount if their course is longer than 14 weeks).

Cancellations

Cancellation prior to arrival Students cancelling their accommodation fewer than 14 days before arrival will be charged a one week accommodation fee - charged at the standard accommodation rate and accommodation placement fee.

Cancellation after arrival **Bookings of 7 weeks or less:** No accommodation refund. **Bookings of 8 weeks and over:** Students must give notice in writing 4 weeks prior to termination otherwise a 4 week cancellation fee will apply.
